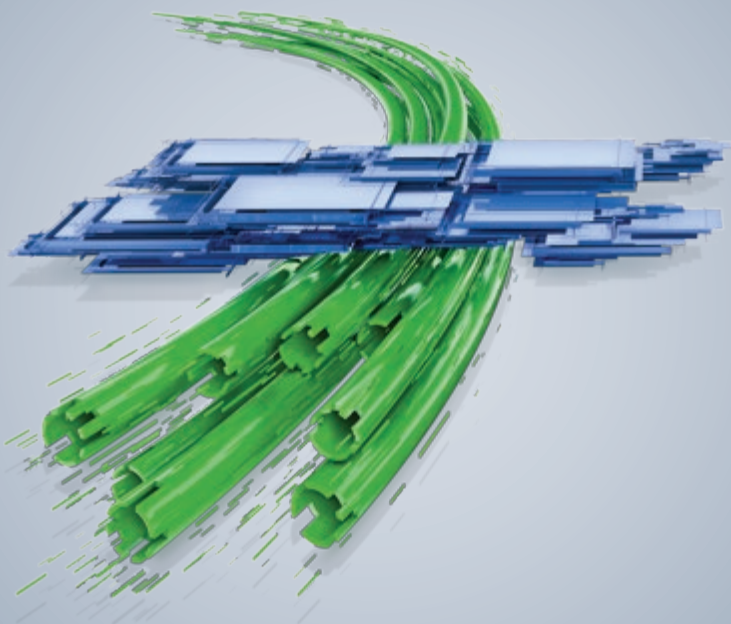

The **Dialog Forum** is the core of the InnoTrans Convention. This event is organized by the Association of German Transport Companies (VDV), the German Transport Forum (DVF), the Association of the European Railway Industry (UNIFE) and the German Railway Industry Association (VDB).

The **Rail Leaders' Summit** (RLS) promotes knowledge-sharing between transport ministers worldwide and general managers of international transport companies – dialog at the highest level. It is organized by Deutsche Bahn, the German Federal Ministry of Transport and Digital Infrastructure, and Messe Berlin.

The **International Tunnel Forum** supports the content of the Tunnel Construction segment and offers a variety of condensed international discussion forums. It is organized by the Research Association for Tunnel and Transportation Facilities (STUVA).

The **Public Transport Forum** focuses on the development of this sector. This forum is arranged by Planungsbüro für Verkehr (PBV) and ETC Transport Consultants GmbH.


The content of the **International Design Forum** focuses on design-related issues in public transport. It is organized by the International Design Center Berlin (IDZ).

Focusing on e-mobility, the subject of buses will be highlighted in the new **International Bus Forum**, organized in cooperation with the Association of German Transport Companies (VDV).

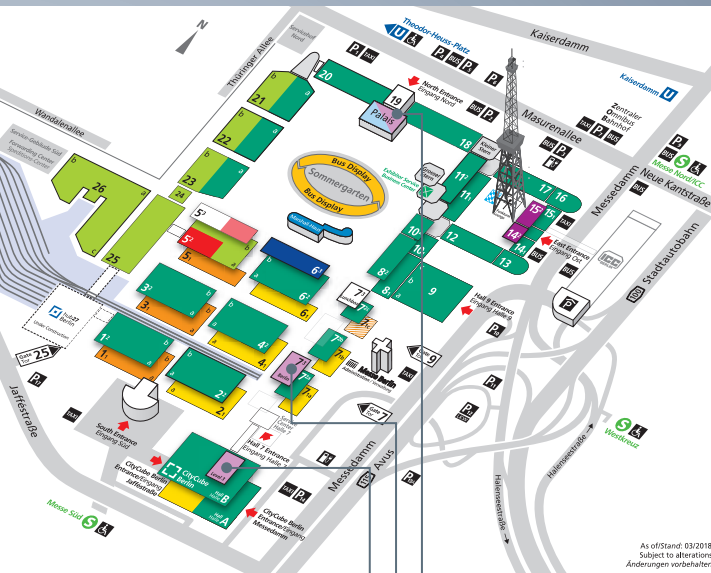
